Issue	Scott Hilton (R)	Mary Robichaux (D)
Gun Safety	Crime is on the rise, but Scott Hilton supports allowing guns on college campuses, while his allies recently passed an extreme gun law that allows people to conceal and carry guns without a license or a background check, including permitting them to take guns into public parks where children play. Local police have warned that this will make it harder for them to do their job, meaning that it will make Georgia families less safe.	Mary Robichaux will work with both parties to pass common-sense background checks for all gun purchases, including ensuring that people on the federal "No Fly" list cannot purchase a gun. She will also fight for judicial procedures for the issuance of Extreme Risk Protection Orders (ERPOs) and increase the legal age for purchasing any weapon to 21 years.
Women's Health	Scott Hilton's allies voted to ban abortion after just six weeks of pregnancy— before most women even know they're pregnant. This extreme ban does not include exceptions for rape and incest, and even its supporters say that it could be used to jail women and their doctors.
