Issue	Matt Reeves (R)	Om Duggal (D)
Women's Health	Matt Reeves is proudly opposed to abortion, so it's no surprise that his allies voted to ban abortion after just six weeks of pregnancy—before most women even know they're pregnant. This extreme ban does not include exceptions for rape and incest, and even its supporters acknowledge that it could be used to jail women and their doctors.	Om Duggal supports ensuring that re- productive health decisions are made by a woman and her doctor. He will oppose extreme bills that ban abortion even in cases of rape and incest or where the life of the mother is threatened. He believes in women's rights to privacy and choice, and he does not believe it is the role of the government to interfere in deeply personal decisions concerning family planning.
