Women's Health	Kevin Whiteford is an extreme candidate on women's health. He opposes abortion in all cases, even if the life or health of the mother is in danger. He also opposes any funding to Planned Parenthood, even though they provide lifesaving cancer screenings.	Joey Andrews will fight to protect women's health in Michigan. He will fight arcane laws that ban abortion even in cases of rape or incest. He believes the decision should be between a woman and her doctor.
