Issue	Lisa DeKryger (R)	John Fitzgerald (D)
Women's Health	Lisa DeKryger is an abortion access extremist. She has said that restricting access is her "number one issue." She supports banning abortion even in cases of rape and incest.	John Fitzgerald will fight to protect women's health in Michigan. He will fight extreme laws that criminalize abortion even in cases of rape or incest. He believes these decisions should be between a woman and her doctor.
Water Quality	Lisa DeKryger is backed by the party bosses who want to loosen regulations on big polluters, allowing them to dump more toxic waste into Michigan's rivers and lakes. Her supporters have blocked efforts to clean up cancer-causing chemicals like PFAS and cut programs that remove toxic waste in drinking water.	John Fitzgerald will work to protect the health of every Michigan community and ensure access to safe, clean drinking water. He supports the Clean Water Plan to protect the Great Lakes, get rid of lead pipes, and upgrade the state's water infrastructure, and will make it a priority to hold polluting corporations accountable for PFAS contamination and force them to clean up their mess.
