Issue	Mike MacDonald (R)	Veronica Klinefelt (D)
Water Quality	Mike MacDonald voted to allow polluters to dump more chemicals into our waterways, block efforts to clean up cancer-causing chemicals like PFAS, and cut programs that remove toxic waste from our drinking water.	Veronica Klinefelt fought to reduce sewage overflow in Lake St. Clair and the Clinton River Watershed, and will continue that work in the State Senate.

Women's Health	Mike MacDonald supports banning a woman's access to abortion, even if they are victims of rape or incest.	Veronica Klinefelt will fight the extreme 1931 law that would ban almost all abortions in Michigan and make abortion a felony punishable by up to 4 years in prison. She will make sure women can make their own healthcare decisions.
