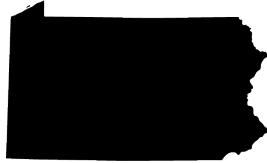


# Pennsylvania Voter Report Card

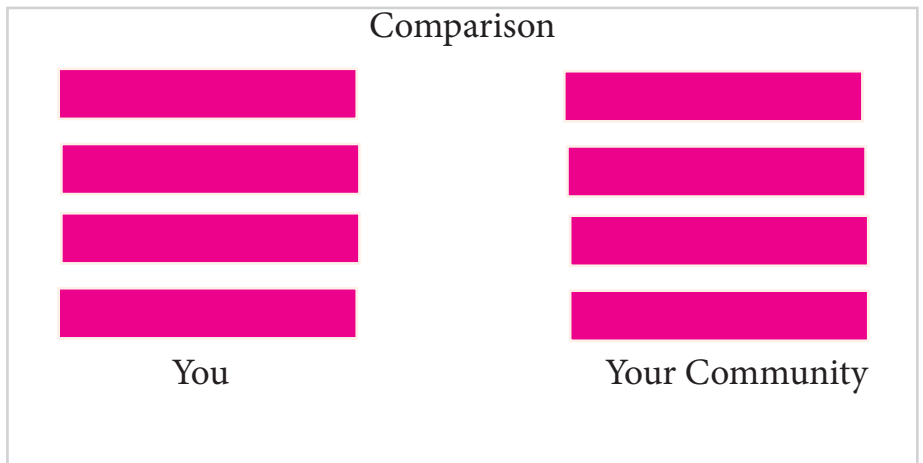
